Rules

Course Information

The first course dated from around 1910, but the advent of WWI, then WWII caused its closure.

The course shown above, which dates from around 1960, ceased to be used around 1990. The creation of the Edinburgh Northern rugby pitch effectively stopped even casual play, although golfers are from time to time seen practising. City of Edinburgh Bye-Laws simply say that sports are permitted on the basis that the public are put in no danger.
